53 God's first decision was to pardon a man by shed blood, and God cannot make the second decision against His first decision. And I'm going to call this fellow, with power not to—to create again, but I'm...He had power to deform, not transform; but to deform. Now, anything deformed is taken from its original state, there is something that's gone wrong with it.
